- 1. Apply: Submit your idea at ingeniousplus.ca.
- 2. Regional Awards: Up to 300 youth from across Canada will receive \$1,000 and access to mentorship and learning opportunities to develop your innovation.
- National Awards: Regional awardees can advance to the national stage for the chance to win one of five \$10,000 awards and be celebrated during Canadian Innovation Week 2026.

#### WHO CAN APPLY

- + Youth aged 14–18 Canadian citizen or permanent resident living in Canada
- + Apply individually or as a team (up to 4)
- + Projects must be youth-led and youth-created
